Project Overview

Milray Contracting were awarded the \$831,000 package from the Charters Towers Regional Council as part of Councils ongoing commitment to maintain their extensive bridge assets across the Council's 70,000km² area.

The package involved the repair and rehabilitation of 9 bridges spread throughout the Council area including both city and rural areas. Most of these bridges are situated on arterial roads on the Council road network and as such delays are to be kept to a minimum. Some bridges require side tracks due to the nature of the repairs required.

With majority of major plant supplied by Milray Contracting work was started promptly and flowed smoothly for the entirety of the project.

During the project some of the sites were inundated by floodwater, however the project is still proceeding on time and on budget. As the project had the potential to disrupt the day to day running of businesses in the areas, effected residents were contacted and updated on works progress and any potential delays.
