**PROJECT SYNOPSIS**

- Collaboration with the design team and client to modify the design including alignment, pavements and drainage to reduce costs
- Clearing and grubbing, topsoil stripping, GST, drainage, earthworks and cement modified pavement and twin coat seal on 4.2km on new access road to Carborough Mine
- Construction of sealed 200 vehicle car park

**Project Overview**

Milray Contracting was awarded the \$3.12M contract at Carborough Downs Coal Mine by Vale Australia as part of their plan to provide a sealed access road with 200 vehicle car park to improve access and provide better amenities for their workforce.

Vale's Carborough Downs underground mine is located in Central Queensland in the Bowen Basin, approximately 20 kilometres east of Moranbah and 180 kilometres southwest of Mackay. Vale has been the operator of the mine since 2007 when the Company entered the Australian market and acquired assets from AMCI Holdings.

The project was successfully completed to the high standard of Environment and Safety regulations outlined by Vale Australia.

Project was completed ahead of schedule with excellent outcome achieved in all areas including quality, environment, safety and relationship management.
