PROJECT SYNOPSIS

- Reconstruction of floodway
- Rehabilitation of severely scoured batters on Roche Hill
- 200t of limestone rock
- 3,000m³ of desilting
- Emulsion seal 15mx15m helipad

Project Overview

Milray Contracting were awarded the \$200,000 package from Newmont Australia as part of the company's ongoing commitment to the rehabilitation of their Mt Leyshon mine site. The contract was awarded based on value for money and a proven track record of delivery of projects of a similar nature for Newmont Australia and other local mining companies.

The package involved repairing of scours on steep waste rock dumps and tailings dams and involved filling of scours with rock fill, placement of embankment fill, topsoiling and the construction of water diversion and silt control structures. Construct new helipad and The construction was completed primarily using Milray Contracting plant plus some dry hire of articulated haul trucks.
