Project Overview

Milray Contracting was awarded the \$118,000 package from PYBAR Mining for the earthworks for the construction of the Far West Portal Box Cut at Thalanga Mine 80km west of Charters Towers. The box cut is used as the entrance to the new underground mine and is part of Red River Resources mining expansion program.

The package involved the clearing and grubbing of the site, drilling and blasting, rock excavation, shotcreting, face bolting and construction of retainment fencing.
